Chapter 1 Task & Methodological structure



Task

The following study presents the first results of the survey on the repositioning of UBT. Five groups of people (= target group) were surveyed. The main focus was on –

- On current developments, threats and future issues in Albania
- In the evaluation of the UBT through a TARGET / ACTUAL profile?
- In the assessment of the subject matter competence of the UBT?

- In possible thematic additions that the UBT should offer in the future?
- In the possible reorientation in the area of transdisciplinary education
- In preparing graduates for the job market



Target Group

Current students, former students (alumni), professors/teaching staff, administrative staff and stakeholders



Survey type

Online interviews with links programmed by market for each of the target groups, dispatch and follow-up contact by the UBT.



Representativeness

The people surveyed were contacted directly by the UBT if contact details were available and asked to participate in the survey. This gives a 100% representative impression, as understandably not all students/alumni have contact details.



Basis for evaluation UBT participants total n=1426 maximum statistical fluctuation range , +/- 2.65 percent








The greatest threats to sustainable development in Albania




The greatest threats to sustainable development in Albania






Future important career fields (for the next 5 to 10 years)






Expectations of University in Albania








Current limitations or weaknesses of the UBT




Preparation for the labor market through UBT




Missing areas of competence and fields of study

In your opinion, which areas of competence and study programs are missing at the Universiteti Bujgësor i Tiranës (UBT) and should be added? **Ouestion:**







Question: In your opinion, which topics and competencies should the University of Bujqësor i Tiranës (UBT) stand?




Differences between UBT and other universities


Differences between UBT and other universities

Question: In which subject areas and fields of expertise currently offered at the Universiteti Bujqësor i Tiranës (UBT) do you see little difference to other Albanian universities?



Question: In which of the following key topics does the University of Bujqësor i Tiranës (UBT) stands out from other universities in Albania?




UBT's key areas of expertise: stands out POSITIVELY

Question: In which of the following key topics does the University of Bujqësor i Tiranës (UBT) stands out from other universities in Albania?








Future need for jobs and specializations in Albania

Question: In which areas do you think there will be more demand for jobs/specializations in Albania in the future?




Future need for jobs or specializations in Albania/I

Question: In which areas do you think there will be more demand for jobs/specializations in Albania in the future?




Future need for jobs and specializations in Albania/II


Strengthening the transdisciplinary approach




Importance of Transdisciplinary Education




Impact of the transdisciplinary approach

Impact of the transdisciplinary approach




Impact in any case (grade 1); differentiated by target groups

Management Summary



- There is a clear need for action in Albania in the quality of education and training, particularly in terms of retaining skilled workers in the country and counteracting emigration.
- When it comes to important professional fields, food and nutrition, water supply
 and veterinary medicine are seen as important professions. In addition, the topic of
 environmental and climate change is currently seen as being treated somewhat
 stepmotherly.
- The expectations of a university are very high, with the clear focus on good career opportunities, high practical relevance, innovation and excellence in research and teaching, and a high level of recognition for the university. However, the level of fulfillment still leaves something to be desired: the gap between target and actual is particularly evident in the perception of professors (practical relevance, excellence in research, high quality and the latest technology) and stakeholders (innovation, technical equipment, good career opportunities and quality).
- Professors subsequently also point to a lack of financial resources, too little cooperation, and too little innovation, practice and modern technologies.
 Professors in particular are somewhat cautious about whether the UBT prepares students well for the job market. There is a lack of practice, modernity and digitalization.





Management Summary



- Currently, the UBT stands for agricultural sciences, veterinary sciences and for the
 environment and ecology. The subject of food only comes in fourth place.
 Differentiating from other universities is not easy. In terms of study, the agricultural
 focus is seen as a USP on the one hand, but also in the combination with
 economics on the other. This picture is supplemented by competence in the field of
 veterinary medicine, the environment and the food technology.
- With the template, veterinary medicine, forestry and agricultural technology, plant
 protection and aquaculture emerge as the fields of study with a particular focus on
 skills. People from agricultural courses also see water management and water
 ecology as essential additions. However, the focus of skills among professors and
 stakeholders is much more reserved than among students. There are also many
 additions, but there is already a clear trend to sharpen the existing fields of study
 and work with more practice and research.
- A transdisciplinary approach is clearly perceived as very positive, i.e. a linking and sharpening of the current fields of study, and people simply expect more opportunities for a career or more opportunities on the job market. The result is also better preparation for the job market, more practical relevance and greater research competence, and thus more innovation.
